Blood Donation Camp

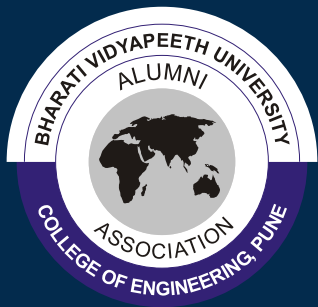
