CIRCULAR

It is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that the rules regarding refund of fees paid by students who subsequently cancel the admission for the academic year 2008-2009 are as follows:

(1) In the event of a student/candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) shall be refunded.

(2) If a student submits his application for cancellation of admission in a prescribed form duly completed within 15 calendar days from the date of commencement of the particular course, 10 percent of total amount of tuition fees prescribed for the course will be deducted from the amount of tuition fee paid by him.

(3) If a student submits his application for cancellation of admission in a prescribed form duly completed within 30 calendar days from the date of commencement of the particular course 25 percent of the total amount of tuition fees prescribed for the course will be deducted from the amount of tuition fee paid by him.

(4) If a student submits his application for cancellation of his admission after 30 calendar days from the date of commencement of the particular course no refund of fees will be made.

(5) Under no circumstances other fees paid by the student will be refunded either in part or in full except the amounts of college and university development fund.

(6) If any student admitted to any of these courses leaves the course at any time after 90 calendar days from the date of commencement of the particular course / after the date of his admission to that course, whichever is later, in an academic year, he will be required to pay full amount of tuition fees for the remaining entire duration of course (i.e. 3 years or as the case may be).
